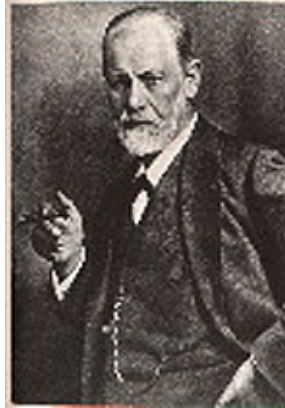

THE GENETIC POINT OF VIEW

STAGE	CENTER OF PLEASURE
ORAL	ORAL CAVITY
ANAL	ANUS
PHALLIC	GENITALIA
LATENT	Sexual motivations recede as the child becomes preoccupied with developing skills and other activities.
GENITAL	GENITALIA

Fixation

ORAL: Optimism/pessimism, gullibility/suspiciousness, manipulativeness/passivity, admiration/envy, cockiness/self-belittlement

ANAL: Stinginess/overgenerosity, constrictedness/expansiveness, stubbornness/acquiescence, orderliness/messiness, rigid punctuality/tardiness, meticulousness/dirtiness, precision/ vagueness

PHALLIC Vanity/self-hatred, pride/humility, blind courage/timidity, brashness/bashfulness, gregariousness/isolation, stylishness/plainness, flirtatiousness/avoidance of heterosexuality, chastity/promiscuity,

Resistance: Words and actions of the analysand that obstructs his gaining access to his unconscious.

Transference: A process of actualisation of unconscious wishes. Transference uses specific objects (especially people) and operates in the framework of the specific relationship established with these objects (people).
