**1ST META LEVEL: CONCURRENTLY REFLECTING ON
ONE'S THINKING ABOUT SOME EXTERNAL MATTER**

**2ND META LEVEL CONCURRENTLY THINKING
ABOUT ONE'S THINKING ABOUT HOW THE MIND IS
FUNCTIONING AS IT THINKS ABOUT THE
EXTERNAL MATTER**
